YES We ask that you please return this document completed with the information requested by February 15, 2020. If we do not receive by the deadline and you are a previous gardener, we will assume you no longer wish to garden. If you do not report your previously assigned plot number(s) for reference, you may be assigned another available plot. All bagged leaves on your plot must be emptied and spread on or before February 15, so the area can be tilled for spring planting. It is imperative that all gardens must be cleaned off by November 1. No carpet or plastic should be used in the gardens as it presents a problem for bush hogging, tilling and clean-up. Violation of these rules may lead to forfeiture of plot(s). ** If the Garden Community sees no evidence of this garden being worked by May 1st, this plot will be assigned to another gardener without further notice.
