ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Petitioner, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, files this Administrative Complaint against Respondent, and alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating the business of buying, selling, or dealing in motor vehicles or offering or displaying motor vehicles for sale, pursuant to section 20.24 and Chapter 320, Florida Statutes, and Rule 28-106.2015, Florida Administrative Code.
- 2. Section 320.27(1)(c)2., Florida Statutes, defines "Independent motor vehicle dealer," or non-franchised motor vehicle dealer, as any person other than a franchised or wholesale motor vehicle dealer who engages in the business of buying, selling, or dealing in motor vehicles, and who may service and repair motor vehicles.
- 3. Respondent is, and has been at all times material hereto, a licensed motor vehicle dealer in the State of Florida, having been issued license number VI-1133073, based upon the application identifying PAUL HENNESSY as President. The physical address of record is 1551 East Silver Star Road, Ocoee, Florida 34761.
